Also Give her my share of marr and a cow & Calf and all my  
Household furniture as shall be hereafter provided.

And I Give and Bequeath to Daughter Patsy a cow & Calf & a feather  
bed and furniture

And I Give unto my Daughter Sarah a cow & Calf & feather bed furniture

4th I Give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Nancy Thirty Dollars

5th I Give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Hesekiah Thirty Dollars

6th All Well and Elsewhere is that my two slaves Melinda & Jeffry Horning  
Be sold for one third Court in hand and one third three months  
Credit & the Other & no other Credit

7th And all the rest of property to be sold at nine months Credit  
to Equally be Divided Between my Wife & Children after my  
last debts being paid. And I hereby make & Ordain my

of this my Last will & Testament in Writing

Whereof I the said Jeffry Horning have to this my Last Will &  
Testament set my hand and seal the day of April above written  
Signed sealed & declared by the said Jeffry Horning in his Last Will &  
Testament in the presence of us who were present at the time of  
signing & seal thereof

Guilford Being by the Blessing of God of sound Mind and Memory  
But considering the uncertainty of life and that it is appointed  
unto all men to die do hereby make and publish this my Last Will  
and Testament in manner following viz. My Body I commit

and as to my Mortal Goods I Direct of them in the following

Bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Child One Negro Girl named  
Consideration that the boy is the Heir of my Son James Stewart  
Re<sup>d</sup> The sum of one Hundred & Two Dollars Likewise One Neg  
Woman named Jane & no boy his child named Andy the boy  
Andy I Give out & Accompanied to my said daughter for her  
To her Care of Supporting a Negro Woman in her Old age Also  
One volume of Scott's family Bible on the side Testament.  
4<sup>th</sup> I Will & Bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Gorrell One horse in  
Choice of all I may also two hundred & Sixty Dollars Likewise the 2<sup>d</sup> Volume of  
Scott's family Bible on the side Testament.

5<sup>th</sup> I Will & Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Sarah Brown  
One Negro Girl named Jane & One Coffin, Cupboard.

6<sup>th</sup> I Will & Bequeath to my other four Grand children children
