1st I Give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife my Black Girl Linda During life after paying One Hundred Dollars to the Estate of her and her increase to belong to my Heirs and I reserve my House and plantation and my Slave the Slavery her Widowhood I also Give her my chaise of man and a cow & calf and all my Household furniture as shall be hereafter more directed.

2nd I Give and bequeath to Daughter Patsy a cow & calf & a feather Bed and furniture

3rd I Give unto my Daughter Sarah a cow & calf & a feather Bed & furniture

4th I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter, Nancy thirty Dollars

5th I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter, Ursula thirty dollars

6th My Will and desire is that my two Slaves Melinda & Mary should be sold for one third Cash in hand and one third three months Credit & the other two months Credit

7th And all the rest of property to be sold at nine months Credit to Equally be divided between my Wife & Children after my last Debts being paid. And I hereby make Ordain my

of this my last will & Testament in the presence of the said Jeffery Horning have to this my last will & Testament set my hand and seal the day & year above written Signed sealed & declared by the said Jeffery Horning as his last will & Testament in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing & seal thereof
