Hyde County I day of July one thousand seven  
hundred and ninety three. I Ann Stude of the County &  
State aforesaid and State of North Carolina being weak of Body  
but of perfect mind an memory Thanks be to God

Known that it is appointed for all persons once to

Item I give to my daughter Sara Johnson one Linnen wheel one large pot one hatch one earthen pot one sawn pigeon one

State of North Carolina John Tuley being sick and indisposed  
 Hyde County - of a sound mind and memory had a desire to make a will and thereby to dispose of his personal property called to him Elizabeth Rew & Jane Tuley on the twenty first day of February one thousand seven hundred & ninety four and desired of them to take notice as witnesses of the same and then did say that his will and desire was that all of his property in and without should go to his son John Tuley and Thomas Tuley and that if son John were returned in that case his son Thomas Tuley was to have all of his property and if his son John Tuley returned that his property should be Equally divided between the two & the day following the witnesses aforesaid says he died -
