with two hundred dollars equally. And I do also
give unto my daughter Elizabeth, one book, called
Dodgson's life & progress, & unto my daughter Sarah one
book called Boston's purg'd State. Unto my son
William McMillin or his lawful heirs I do give & bequeath
one hundred & one dollar. I give & bequeath unto my
son Samuel McMillin or his heirs, one hundred &
forty eight dollars & forty eight dollars of the above
as or has been already recd. for Sam. & the one hundred
to be paid to him by my Executors.

I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Brown
two children fifty five dollars & my side saddle
thirty dollars of the fifty five to be given to her son
William & twenty five to her daughter Elizabeth & the said
side saddle.

I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Rachael
Lockman's two children David & Rachael
& Lockman one dollar each.

 being of sound and perfect mind & memory, beforesaid
 be God, do this 18th day of December Anno Dⁱ 1826
 make and publish this my last will & Testament in
 manner following, that is to say, First I give & bequeath
 to my beloved wife Esther all my ^{money &} real & moveable
 property, except fifty dollars, which I bequeath to my
 grandson Henry, son of John Bengel, which is to be
 paid out for his schooling. My wife Esther shall also
 have privilege to live in the dwelling house where I
 now live & my son John Bengel shall find her sufficient
 meat, drink and cloathing during her natural life
 & after her decease the said John Bengel shall have
 all that is in her possession, except money & notes which
 if there be any remaining shall be divided in three
 equal parts, the one third to my daughter Mary Ann
 Childers, the one third to my daughter Sally Clay Childers
 & the one third to my daughter Barbara Wood.
 And I make and seal my beloved son
