As touching such worldly stuff as it hath pleased God to bless
me with in this life I give direct charge of in the following manner
It is my will that my Father & Mother's grave something done
to them I give one hundred to that use It is my will that my
just debts should be paid It is my will that my land should
be sold & my other stuff It is my will that none of my
concern themselves without business I give my Brother Robert
Graham my neysa girl Flora & at his death to his son John
Graham I give my niece Margaret Graham one hundred
Dollars to be laid out of my estate I give my wife Elmine
Graham I give my brother William Graham for
the use of his son William one hundred dollars to come out
of my estate I give to my Brother Archibald Graham one
hundred Dollars I give my boy Sam to William Johnson
to him & his Heir forever & the remainder I do leave to
William Graham to him & his Heir forever to do with
it otherwise as he may see fit & appoint him my sole Executer of this my last
will & Testament I do hereby utterly revoke & disannul
all former other Testaments, Ratifying the same & making
no other to be my last will & Testament, In witness whereof I
have set the day & year first above written

In the name of God Amen I Abner Brown of the
County of Chehalis in the State of Washington being on the
decline of life but of sound mind & memory do make
a true & just copy of my last will & Testament now made

gave it, & my body to the dust to be buried in a decent
manner at the direction of my executors, and leaving
such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with in
this life & dispose of in the following way and manner -
Hence, I will bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary the whole
of my estate both real & personal after paying my just debts
to be here during her natural life & then divide the
disposed of in the following manner that is the whole of the
balance remaining on hand at the death of my wife to be
sold at publick sale & my executors pay my grand daughter
Mary before Wilson ten dollars also my grand son Alexander
Wilson & my grand daughter Nancy Pinina Wilson
children of my daughter Mary sixteen dollars each -
Nevertheless should my executors think it best to sell a
part or the whole of my lands in such case I hereby give them
full power to make good & sufficient letters for the same to
the minors arising from said sale to put into the hands of my
wife Mary for her comfort & convenience & at her pleasure the
above sum ... to be paid out of the balance to be equally
divided amongst my four daughters viz Elizabeth
Kennicott, Sarah McLean, Dorcas Pinina & Leannah
Kennicott these & their children and I hereby nominate &
constitute James Tribble in my whole & sole executor of this
my last will & testament, the witness whereof have hereunto
set my hand back this 13th day of October 1829.
