the use of his son William one hundred dollars to come out
of my Estate. I give to my Brother Joseph Graham one
hundred Dollars - I give my boy Sam to William Johns son
to him & his heirs forever - & the remainder I do bequeath to
William Graham to him & his heirs forever - to be
likewise assign to him my sole Executor of this my last
will & Testament - I do hereby utterly revoke & disannul
all & every other Testament, Ratifying & confirming this to
be my last will & Testament, In witness whereof
I have signed the day & year first above written -

children of my daughter Mary fifteen dollars each -
Nevertheless should my Executors think it best to sell a
part or the whole of my land in such case I hereby give them
full power to make good & sufficient titles for the same &
the money arising from said sale be put into the hands of my
wife Mary for her comfort & convenience & at her death the
above sum to be paid out & the balance to be equally
divided amongst my four daughters viz Elizabeth
Kennebec Sarah M'Kenzie Dorcas Kennebec & Leannah
Kennebec share & share alike - And I hereby nominate &
constitute James Wilson my whole & sole Executor of this
my last will & Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & back this 15th day of October 1829.
