City of Newbern, & State of North Carolina, leaving in a loose  
state of health the best of sound mind & memory. Wishes be to  
God there or, nothing to mind that it is appointed for all  
men once to die; Do make & ordain this my last Will and  
Testament; that is to say principally and first of all, to give  
my soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it & on  
body I recommend to the earth to be Buried in a decent man  
at the discretion of my executors; and as touching such  
worldly estate wherewith I leave behind God to bless in his  
life. I give & dispose of the same in the following manner  
and form viz.

I. I give & bequeath unto Dennis Alexander my beloved wife  
all that part or parcel of the plantation wherein I now live  
which contains my mansion house & improvements to pay  
the same during the term of her natural life together with  
my two Negroes named David & Tom, & 1000 lbs of the best  
clothing the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars & a girl named Ann  
& her Head & 1000 pounds more, and in like wise & bequeath unto  
her one good house & kitchen, & bedchamber with its furniture with all  
kitchen & kitchen furniture, also a mill and part of all my kitchen  
furniture which may remain after the payment of my several  
debtors hereafter bequeathed.

II. To my beloved wife Dennis Alexander my dear friends  
I give & bequeath to Elizabeth Alexander my only daughter one  
hundred and five pounds.

III. I give & bequeath unto Abraham Hines, my son the sum  
of fifty pounds, together with one Good Horse & saddle, to  
pay him before he may arrive at the age of twenty one years.

IV. I give & bequeath unto Jacob Alexander two hundred &  
one acres of land being the Southern part or division of my  
plantation wherein I now live.

V. I give & bequeath unto Ezra Alexander my son (eldest)  
recommend to be taught the trade or occupation of a  
carpenter other Mecklenburg Co., NC Wills 1783-1844

2 I promise & intend to pay to my son Cyrus  
a liberal Education under the direction of my  
especial friends & to him the sum of £100 per  
annum until he may arrive at the age of majority.

Item It is my will & direct that my son Cyrus shall rec-  
ieve an English name, which has been given to  
my other child, and also I give it to my other  
son that placed or chosen of my choice which you  
and others know in my present improvements to his  
name & signs for me to name to him at his birth  
the name of his mother.

Item This is my will & I make & witness after my desire  
that my estate & estate now and before disposed of shall be so  
by publick Landau and the monies arising therefrom to  
after paying off all my just debts and all the above  
mention'd legacies be equally divided amongst  
six years old children and in case any one or more  
of them should decease before the age of twenty one  
then their portions & shares bequeathed shall be  
divided amongst those of them who may survive  
And I do hereby constitute & appoint my dearest son  
John Daviss Alexander & my two sons Isaac Abraham  
the second to be my sole executor of this my last will &  
testament, and his trustees & executors for all my  
above named that age in their minority, and I do so  
strictly desirous, that I discharge all & every  
former Testaments wills & legacies by me in any wise made  
willed or Agreed & done before, Ratifying & Confirming this and  
the same to be my last Will and Testament, In witness whereof I  
have affixed my hand & seal to the same set my hand  
Seal this 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 1786

Signed, sealed, pronounced & declared by the  
said Abraham Alexander as his last will  
& testament in the presence of us who are his friends  
his friends being in the presence of each other  
and have affixed their hands thereto this 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 1786
