& at the discretion of my family & to be referred to God who
gave it. not out of fear but sincerely hoping & relying
upon the mercy and forgiveness through the precious speaking
Blood of Christ - Be the second Man to be referred to God who
blessed me & I disclaim all it in the last Will & Testament

1st I will that my beloved wife & I separate the full
use of my land & building all & to be referred to God who
blessed me & I disclaim all it in the last Will & Testament

2^d I will that my land at his death be sold & Equally divided
between my two sons Robert and John Allen.

3^d I will that my negro man Simon be sold & as much of
my movable property as shall be necessary or as my beloved
wife may not object to keep be sold & with my best debt to pay
the balance remaining to be equally divided between my
three daughters viz Eliza or Duckworth, Ann Harris and
(Margaret Duckworth).

4th I will to my son Robert Allen my large family Bible my
other books to be Equally divided between all my children
my beloved wife to have the use of them while she lives.

5th I do hereby constitute and appoint James Harrison &
Richard Harris to be the Executors of this my last Will &
Testament, and I do hereby Name me all other debts
owed by me or in my Name September 15th 1819
