 & Testament that is to say principally & first I recommend
 my Soul to God who gave it, And my body to be buried
 in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my
 Executors, lands as touching & with goods where with it is
 pleased God to bless me with I desire of them in the
 following manner

Impressis It is my Will & pleasure that all my estate be sold by my
 Executors and of the money there arising after all my
 debts are paid be divided as follows

Item I will & bequeath the unto my best beloved Daughter Sophia
 the sum of Forty Shillings, and the further sum
 of Twenty pounds I will to each of my two eldest Daughters
 Viz. Arimanta and Lucretia And it is further my will
 and pleasure that all the remainder of my estate be equa-
 lly divided among my three other Daughters Viz. Joseph Alexandra
 Margaret Cannon, Ann Cannon Elizabeth Cannon, George Cannon
 & a others more to be named

And I do hereby appoint my beloved son Joseph Cannon
 and my brother in law John Mitchell Alexandra to be my sole
 & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament. Hereby
 revoking all former Wills Gifts & Legacies, Ratifying and
 confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament
 Sealed with my seal & dated this 28th day of July 1775
 Signed, Sealed, Published, Pronounced

& declared by the said Catherine Alexandra
 as her last Will & Testament, who in her presence & in the presence of each other
