mind the Mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed
unto all men once to die. Do make & Ordain this my last Will
& Testament that is to say principally & first I recommend
my Soul to God who gave it, And my body to be buried
in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my
Executors, And as touching such goods where-with it is
pleased God to bless me with I desire of them in the
best manner

First It is my Will & pleasure that all my estate be sold by my
Executors and of the money there arising after all my
debts are paid be divided as follows -

Item I will & bequeath unto my well beloved Daughter Sophia
Sharpe the sum of Forty Shillings, and the further Sum
of £100 pounds I will to each of my two Eldest Daughters
Viz: Ann Maria and Levis. And it is further my Will
and pleasure that all the remainder of my estate be equa-
lly divided among my three Son Catharine Viz Joseph Alexander
Mary and Canon, Ann Canon George Brown, George Cannon
& Catharine Sharpe -

And I do hereby appoint my beloved son Joseph Cannon
and my brother in law John Mithell Alexander to be my sole
& sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament. Hereby
revoking all former Wills Gifts & Legacies, Ratifying and
confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament
Sealed with my seal & dated the 28th day of July 1775

& declared by the said Catherine Alexander
as her last Will & Testament, who in her presence & in the presence of each other
