I Charles Alexander of North Carolina State, Mecklenburg County  
being of sound & perfect mind & memory do this 28<sup>th</sup> day of January  
1781. Make & publish this my last will & testament in me same  
following that is to say. First I release all my just debts, to  
be paid out of such part of my movable property as my executors  
may think best.

Item I give & bequeath to my wife Jean one Negro man named Tom  
and woman named Tyna during her natural life. Then they are  
to be in three other children of my children they will live with  
and further than to whom they shall go to shall not be given  
them to want during their old age or infirmities. And  
further after paying debts she is to be possessed of the remain-  
der of Horses, cattle Sheep and Hogs the Headfield & Kitchen  
servitude Bedding &c to be divided between his and my  
two daughters equally Jean & Cassandra & to have possession  
of my farming utensils with the house and as much —  
land and woodland to support it as my executors  
may think fit as, & open skirt they are to hold during  
a single life of either —

Item I give to my son Charles our negro boy named Job & one negro  
girl named Maria on provision that my son Adams never  
returns if he does she is to be Adams so he resides in  
County — Item I give to my son George our Negro boy &  
named Lewis on provision that Adams goes along <sup>with</sup> the  
sons he is to be Adams so he resides in this <sup>old</sup> name  
Item I give to my Daughter Jean one Negro boy  
Billy with his offspring —

Item I give to my daughter Cassandra one <sup>girl named</sup>  
Dove and one boy named Tom <sup>girl named Linda</sup>

Item I give to my Daughter Peggy one  
and boy named Bob

Item I give to my son Adam (the in

except that his Mothers and sisters are to have and if  
he should never return & settle in this Country then it  
is to be equally divided between my three daughters  
Hannah, Elizabeth & Mary and equally after the death  
of Richard Alexander & wife for their own habited portion  
of Land lying in Cumberland I hereby empower either  
of my executors to make back Testate to Richard Alexander  
and Elizabeth Mother and Captain my three sons Charles,  
George & Addison Executors of this my last will & Testament  
In witness whereof I the said Charles Alexander have  
to this my last will & Testament set my hand and seal  
the day and year above mentioned.
