In the name of God Amen, I Daniel Alexander of
Mecklenburg County in the province of North Carolina
being sick & weak in body but of sound memory do
be God for it, And expecting my Dissolution to be nigh
do make declare and publish this my last will & Testament
which is as follows - First I Order that my estate to be
Given & bequeath to my dear and beloved wife Prudence
Horse and Saddle & her bed and bed clothes and all her other things
which she owns, And two cows & hares and six sheep with my
wrench named Moll, And the Shuff planishing between her &
my Daughter Margaret and her spinning wheel
Item, I give and bequeath unto my son James a negro child
my Wench Moll is with, if it live
Item, I give & bequeath to my son William a negro child named Gert
Item, I give & bequeath to my son Stephen a negro girl named N
Item, I give & bequeath unto my son Jonathan the plantation
I now live on, And the buildings & appurtenances
and the land on which they stand shall have a room to
be built for the same

I and my wife Mary being together between my son Williams and Thomas Littlelands and his horse saddle and some more and the two sold a, saddle and a buck skin and his body clothes and a pair of Tackling & a negro boy named Jack to my son & Margaret for one hundred pounds to be paid him and of my horse and my young black mare and his saddle & matters. I have a girl named Nancy & my son & Margaret the said my daughter who is my young horse and his saddle and two horses & calves and a feather bed, and clothes and till his body clothes and a young negro female named Dorothea and a young boy named Jim. I give and bequeath unto my son Nicholas one hundred & fifty acres of land joining my own plantation & a negro boy named Frank and I have him in care of my son Matthew and his brother & Matthew who is to school him and his brother who is to have his work and the work of his negro boy, until he is sixteen or the age of 20 years that his brother & Matthew shall give him to Horse Valley by my executors to twenty pounds price & a new saddle & two calves & in case of death to be my executors share. I bequeath further to the said remainder of my goods & chattels sold and my debts collected and after the one hundred pounds is received to be paid & bequeath to my son Nicholas. I do the said my wife & children get the third part of the remainder and the other two parts to be equally divided between my son Matthew, Joseph, Margaret and Nicholas. I do the said my son Nicholas & his wife & children to be the sole executors of the said my last will & Testament, and to make, execute, & give my will in writing according to the true intent & meaning thereof. In witness whereof I the said Daniel Alexander have hereunto set my hand and seal the 15th day of March in the year of our Lord 1776.
