I David Allison being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be unto God calling unto myself the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make and declare this my last Will & Testament that is to say Principally & first of all I Give & recommend my Soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it, And my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Buriall at the discretion of my next of kin nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God at the general Resurrection. And as I have long been desirous to be buried with it be it pleased God so to bless me with in this life I Give Order Dispose of the same in the following manner and form. - First of all I Give & bequeath to Valentine Hiff my son in law one Dollar. - Second I Give & bequeath to my son in law Andrew Hiff one Dollar - 3^d I Give & bequeath to my daughter Hiff Daughter to my son in law Andrew Hiff all the remainder of my estate Real and personal - And do hereby make & ordain my executors Executors & Administrators Henry & Robert Crockett my whole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament and do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills & Grants by me made or written and do signify and confirm this and no other to be my last Will & Testament in witness whereof I have set my hand & Seal this 16th day of June 1855 signed sealed published pronounced & declared by David Allison as his last Will & Testament in the presence of us who in the presence of each other in his presence have hereunto set our names -
