In the name of God Amen. This 8th day of May in the year
of our Lord 1790 I David Alexander of the County of Middlebury
in the State of North Carolina being sick & weak in body
but of a perfect sound mind & knowing that he is to God
And calling to mind the mortality of my body and that it is
apparent to me all men once to die Do make this my last
will & Testament: First of all recommending my soul into
the hands of God who gave it and my body to the earth to be
buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my
Executors hereafter named nothing doubting but by Jesus the
Son of God at the general Resurrection by the mighty power
of God passing through the merits death and passion of my
Lord and our common Christ to receive a full and com-
pardon of all my sins and to inherit everlasting life
with all touching such worldly estate as at this present I do
possess or hereafter I may receive by gift or devise
And as touching the following manner of my Will
First of all I will that all those Debts and Duties that I owe to any
person or persons be paid and satisfied by my Executors
hereafter named -
Then I give I bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth my dwelling
house, the bed and furniture thereto belonging with the Table
and furniture thereto belonging including pot & a couple
of Cows & my horse to the value of twenty five pounds

with a saddle and bridle to be leaved out of my Estate on Negro
woman named Natcha, her maintenance in my house during
her widowhood and all above mentioned to be at her own
disposal ~~except the house~~ house to her her heirs & assigns forever —
I give & bequeath to my daughter Fanny Twenty Shillings current
money to be leaved out of my Estate to her & her heirs forever —
I give & bequeath to my son James Twenty Shillings current
money to be leaved out of my Estate to him & his heirs forever —
I give & bequeath to my son David Twenty Shillings current money
to be leaved out of my Estate to him & his heirs forever —
I give & bequeath to my son Isaac & Ephraim each my plant &
iron implements to be equally divided between them and
it is my will and I order that my said sons Isaac & Ephraim
shall maintain their Mother in a plentiful
dwelling in manner during her widowhood as above mentioned
I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary one Negro boy named
George with one bed & furniture with a saddle & bridle with
one gun & calfs with a two year old mare to her & her heirs forever
I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah one Negro boy named Peter
a saddle & bridle and one cow & calfs to her and her heirs forever and
one bed and furniture —
I give & bequeath to my daughter Fanny Twenty pounds current
money to be leaved out of my Estate with a saddle and bridle
one cow & calfs with a bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever —
It is my will & I order that my son Ephraim gets a horse & saddle
to Twenty pounds current money to be leaved out of my Estate
I give & bequeath to my wife Elizabeth two cows & calves of her
own choosing and to her heirs forever —
It is my will and I order that the two plantations one known
by the name of Lotions place and the other known by the
of the Neck river land be sold in order to pay debts and Legacies
and after the payment of all debts & legacies if any remain
I would be well satisfied that the said money of my Estate including my
Cattle and horse to be sold

Item. I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary one negro boy named George with one bed & furniture with a saddle & bridle with one Cow & Calf with a two year old mare to her & her Heirs, forever

Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah one negro boy named Peter a saddle & bridle and one Cow & Calf to her and her Heirs, forever with one bed and furniture -

Item. I give & bequeath to my daughter Fanny Twenty pounds current money to be levied out of my Estate with a saddle and bridle one Cow & Calf with a bed & furniture to her & her Heirs forever -

Item. It is my will & I order that my son Ephraim gets a Horse & cart to Twenty pounds current money to be levied out of my Estate -

Item. I give & bequeath to my wife Elizabeth two Cows & calves of her own choosing and to her Heirs forever -

Item. It is my will and I order that the two plantations one known by the name of Solomon's place and the other known by the name of the Nesting river land be sold in order to pay debts and Legacies and after the payments of all debts & Legacies if any remain should be with the Residue part of my Estate including my Cattle and Hogs to be equally divided among my Children namely Isaac, Ephraim, Mary, Sarah, & Fanny to them and their Heirs forever -

Item. It is my will and I order that the debts due from my son Isaac as to me if he is now dead and the rest can be so be equally divided among my Children -

Item I name, nominate, constitute and appoint my loving wife Elizabeth & my two sons Isaac & Ephraim Executors of this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking & annulling all former & other wills & bequests and devises here before making & confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament -

In the name of God Amen. I Nathaniel Alexander of the State of North Carolina & County of Wake being of sound mind & memory (blessed be God for it) do this 20th day of March in the year of our Lord 1806 make and publish this my last will & Testament in manner and form following Viz First I recommend my Soul to God as unto a faithful Creator, and my Body to be interred in a decent plain manner at the discretion of my execs & other lawfully

It is my desire that all my just debts be paid as soon as possible -

I do devise & bequeath to my beloved wife Mary (so long as she remains my widow) the House I now live in with all the other buildings and also full privilege of the plantation I now live on including the 175 Acre tract I purchased from Joseph Ab. 107 that I obtained of the depletion of my father in all two hundred & eighty two Acs, I also bequeath to my beloved wife my two negro men Dick & Caesar and my Negro Girl Diana also three head of horses and of my stock of her own choice also six head horned cattle of her own choice, also all my other things & effects belonging to me and so on
