to her use - 3^d I also give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Mary Williamson one good bed & furniture & also my Gray mare & saddle & bridle - 4th I order that all my stock of every kind but there are above mentioned & all the other property to me belonging be sent to public sale & the money arising therefrom to be put out on interest until her convenience - 5th I order that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate, and also all debts coming to me be collected by my Executors which hereafter will be mentioned - 6th The estate of my daughter Mary Williamson left to her by her Grandfather Dehesty I leave in the hands of my Executors until she becomes of age to receive it - 7th I also leave my beloved daughter Mary Williamson in the care of my sister Jenny & leave her to raise & to school & to be brought up under her tuition till of age. Lastly I appoint my brother Matthew Williamson of said County to be my lawful Executor of this my last will & Testament, and disavow & make void all other wills by me made & last thing to be my last will & Testament & to remain as such.
