Lastly I appoint my brother Matthew McLean of said County to be my lawful executor of this my last will & testament and desirous to make void all other wills by me made & take this to be my last will & testament & to remain at such time and under my hand & seal the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord 1830 Ratified signed sealed by me in presence of,
