tural life the tract of land on which I now live

tract also my negro boy Bill & our lot &
her nature like mine all the house hold &
kitchen furniture & her choice of five head
of cows & two of the best horses & with
grazing for the same one sow and pigs or
sheep. Ten head of sheep like mine all
