also the rest she may to my sister Nancy also that she pay to
my brother John, also that she pay to my sister Betty also
that she pay to my sister Sally each one of them fifty
dollars in the space of two years after my death -
I also will all my weareing clothes to my brother Andrew
Allison - I also will & bequeath my bed & furniture to my
sister Mary Berryhill, also will my chest to Peggy
Berryhill - I also will a small Table to Lucy Clark & also
will my corn & fodder more feedable and bridle Cows & Hogs
be sold to pay my debts -

I constatale Andrew Clark and Samuel Burghill my executors
of this my last Will and Testamente to witness whereof I have
set my hand and seal this 10th day of October A.D.

manner & form following Viz First This is my Will and

debts in such way as may best comport with the interest of
my soiles Poor but Just & her Daugther Susan Julian -
I give & bequeath to my sister Martha to be bearing her Nellie
all life & all the tract of land on which shee nowe stands
about one hundred & forty acres more or les and all
my stock of cattle & Hogs my little sonne more with
Household & Kitchen furniture with all my furnishing

Together with all the crop now growing on the part which
is not rented out, with all that will be due at
the end of the year for rent all of which she my said sister
may use as she may think most proper -

3rdly It is my will & desire that at the death of my said sister Rachael
Julian, that the tract of Land here in before given her for life
be the property of my niece Susan Julian & I do hereby
give the same to her and to her heirs forever - Provided
nevertheless she shall be bound to pay to the heirs of my
brother William Alexander of Tennessee the sum of Two
hundred Dollars and to pay Mary the wife of George an
annual sum of One Dollar each of which legacies shall
be paid in some reasonable time after the death of her
said Mother Rachael Julian -

4thly It is my will and desire that whatever part of the personal
property herein before given to my sister Rachael Julian for life
remain at her death with all its interest if any shall
be, and I do hereby give to my niece Susan Julian to her and
to her heirs forever - thereby revoking & canceling all other
wills. In witness whereof I have set my name and seal
with my hand this 25th day of April 1826 -

Having omitted to make Læsities in the above place
I also now hereby appoint my friend Paris Alexander
Stephens Esq. Executor to this my last Will
Signed & sealed in presence of
Stephen Fox.
