 In the name of God Amen. This 12<sup>th</sup> day of August in  
 the year of our Lord 1828 - I Elizabeth Alexander of the County  
 of Mecklenburg in the State of North Carolina being very  
 sick & weak in body but in a perfect sound mind & memory  
 with my hands free & willing to mind my mortality so that  
 it is a point for all men to see that I make & ordain this  
 my last will & testament in the following manner & form  
 First I recommend my soul to God who gave it  
 my body to the earth to be buried in an decent manner  
 not doubting but to receive the same again at general  
 resurrection by the power of God hoping that the merits death  
 & passion of my Lord Jesus Christ to receive a full  
 and free pardon of all my sins and at last to inherit Everlasting  
 Life - And as touching such worldly estate as God hath blessed  
 me with in this life I give & devise the same in the fol-  
 lowing manner and form First I do hereby declare that  
 all my just debts & funeral charges be satisfied by my Executors  
 hereafter named -

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I give & bequeath to my loving daughter Susannah Johnston one  
 negro boy named Fanny together with the said Fanny's address to be paid to  
 her when she comes of age at the division hereafter named  
 If this said Susannah Johnston is not equal in value to  
 the other Legatee, I order that she shall have an equal  
 value of Fanny to her other share of the same

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I give & bequeath to my loving wife Rachel after my debts  
 are paid the whole balance of my Estate for the term of 15 years  
 and then my whole Estate is to be given by divided with  
 between my wife & my Daughter Abigail & will that is  
 Younger & if my wife Rachel should marry or get involved  
 in any way of taking care of our children or property of  
 such a Division to take place within the 15 years -

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I name, name, name, name & appoint my well bel. and  
 friends and viz James Gibbons, Ephraim Alexander

and wife Sarah Execut as after my last will & Testament  
sincerely Revoking & disannulling all former wills & bequeaths  
made by me herebefore either by word or writing. Ratifying  
confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament  
Signed sealed pronounced & acknowledged by the  
said Testator in the presence of us

In the presence of God amen. I Edward Alexander of the County of  
Mecklenburg & State of N. Carolina being to wit of sound mind  
& perfect memory & knowing the state in which I am, on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of  
November in the year of our Lord 1822. constitute & publish to be  
declared this my last will & Testament in manner following viz  
I give & bequeath unto my Grand daughter Nelly Kennedy thirty  
dollars in money at my decease, I also at my decease give  
& bequeath thirty dollars more to my Grand daughter Nelly  
Moan - I do also give & bequeath unto my two Grand children  
Thomas M'Alexander & Eliza Alexander all the shares that will  
fall to my son Matthew Alexander & his father & also my son  
Matthew of his share untill his two children Maria & Eliza  
comes of age & then said share to be equally divided between  
said children, and I further allow that all the remaining  
part of my property to be sold & equally divided between all  
my children viz Thomas Alexander, James Alexander, Matthew  
Alexander, David Alexander, Francis M'Alexander, Josiah Alexander  
& my two Daughters Abigail Kennedy & Anne Moan. An equal part  
of my Estate - And now I do hereby appoint my son  
Thomas Alexander and my son in law James Moan my  
Legal Executors. To execute this my last will & Testament -  
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal  
this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year of our Lord 1822 -
