of my real Estate - I Bequeath to my son Andrew the other half of my real Estate - I Bequeath to my son in law John Berry half one part
and the rest of the legacies one dollar each, the House
and the personal property to stand as it is during the
life of my wife the Land to be equally divided between
the old woman and my son Andrew and no alteration
to be made in my personal property during the life
of my wife but for her to have the disposal of the
Household furniture except the Cupboard which I leave
to my Son Andrew.
