general resurrection, and as I am hereby directed to be
buried with it he that is the God to help me with in this life
I give over & dispose of the same in the following manner and
manner. - First of all I give & bequeath to Valentine Hiff my son
in law one Dollar. - Second I give & bequeath to my son
Samuel Andrew Hiff one Dollar - 3rd I give & bequeath to
Margaret Hiff Daughter to my son in law & Andrew Hiff
all the remainder of my estate Real and personal
which do hereby make & declare my last will & testament
which I & Robert Crockett my whole & sole Executors of this my
last will & Testament and do hereby utterly disavow revoke
and disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills
& gifts by me made or written and do signify and confirm
this and no other to be my last will & Testament in witness
whereof I have set my hand & seal this 16th day of June 1855
Signed sealed published pronounced & declared by
David Allison as his last will & Testament in the
presence of the witnesses in the presence of such other
witnesses as he has hereunto set and signed

In the Name of God Amen, I George Allen of Mecklenburg
County in the Province of North Carolina being weak of
body but of perfect mind & memory calling to my mind the
mortality of my body as it is appointed for all men once to
die I do therefore make this my last will & Testament
I give my body to be decently buried and all funeral
charges to be paid and all my just debts to be paid
I give & bequeath to Sarah my beloved wife and to her

with her mare and Saddle with a third of all my
personal Estate.

Item I Will & Bequeath to my Son George the plantation I
now live on, he paying to my Daughters the sum of one
hundred & Twenty pounds when he arrives at the age of
Twenty one years, but provided the Child my wife is now
with be a Son, then I allow him one half of said tract
of Land they my said sons paying my Daughters the sum of
fifty pounds when of age said Land to be divided by my
executors here in after manner.

Item I Will & Bequeath to my Daughters Mary, Jean, Sarah &
Elizabeth and if the Child my wife is now with be a
Female all the remainder of my Estate to be equally di-
vided amongst them except Ten pounds and my riding
(marked Lane & line paper) to my Daughter Mary her
boarding time in her time.

Item I Will & Bequeath unto my brother John Allen one suit
of Blue Fustian Clothes.

Item I Will & Bequeath to Thomas Wade my riding Saddle -
I also order my executors to sell and dispose of my negro
wrench at the pleasure of my personal estate or at public
sale which ever they think best.

Lastly I Will Order Constables appoint & return a Just
Allen my beloved wife, my brother John Allen & Thomas
Pollock to be my Executors of this my last Will & Testament
I do revoke all former Wills and all former Wills
Testaments heretofore made done or executed by me in
things whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 14th
of April 1770 -
