

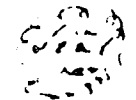
inform & manner, following, That is to say I do give & bequeath unto my beloved

Daughters one pound, I do bequeath to each of my three grandsons
named for me ten dollars when they arrive at the age of Twenty
one years - And lastly as to the real residue & remainder of my
real & personal Estate of whatsoever kind I give & bequeath to my
Younger son Matthew whom I do appoint with my beloved
wife Jane sole Executors of this my last will & Testament, hereby
revoking all former wills by me made. In Witness hereunto
I have set my hand & seal this 20th day of August in the year
of our Lord 1802 & the 27th of American Independence.

"In the name of God Amen. I Henry Hargrett, Sen^r of the State of No
Carolina & County of Wakeham, being weak of body, but of
perfect Sense & memory blessed be God, Do make, declare, express
& constitute this my last will & Testament in manner & form
following, i.e., First I Give my Soul to God, from whom I
received it, my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in
a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors
& as for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bestow
on me I Give & bequeath in manner & form following, to wit
First I Give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Hannah Hargrett
the land & plantation whereon I now live with all my stock
consisting of Hogs Horses & Cattle household furniture of all kinds
working tools & every other good & valuable that I am possessed
of one hundred Acres of land at the Swamp Creek after all just debts
is paid, with one Cow called Filler given to Elizabeth Cherry

One half to James Cheney, one half to Jane Craig one half to
William Cheney Jun. one half named travelling except the
 Above gifts all my land goods Chattels & property I give to my
 well beloved wife Hanna Hergott during her natural life &
 after her decease it is my last will & Testament that the whole
 Estate Real & personal be Equally divided among my Children
Henry Hergott Jun. Elizabeth Cheney, Peter Hergott, Rachel
Pellum, Rebecca Brown, Joseph Hergott, Mary Craig, Sarah
Helms, Daniel Hergott, Lyons Leary. Lastly I nominate
 app. and I constitute this my last will & Testament in the hand
 of my beloved Son Henry Hergott Jun. & Joseph Hergott Esq.
 to this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I the
 said Henry Hergott Jun. have hereunto set my hand & seal this
 28th day of March 1803.

 being in a sick & low condition but of sound & perfect mind
 & memory blessed be God, Do make & publish this my last will
 & Testament in manner following - that is to say -
 First I give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary born &
 during her natural life Eight negroes. Viz Lucy, Frank
Fredrick, Reina, Charly, Hager, Sylvia & Prudy and all the household
 furniture which includes all the beds & bedding, tables, dishes, cups,
 & board &c. all which are are now in her possession. Also one Bay
 Horse - Also her right to occupy possess & enjoy all the right & privileges
 on or into one certain tract of about 200 acres of land that I bought
 of Adam Brown and all the above Legacy she is to possess during her
 natural life & then to descend to her children as hereafter directed
 them. I give & bequeath to my beloved Grand daughter the Sarah Harper
Daughter one negro Wench named Becky one negro girl named
Pegg, one negro boy named Sandy & one negro boy named Shago to
 continue with them in service or upon from this time & on as before
