under my son Jason Alexander to pay my son John Brown
the sum of twenty pounds Current Money of Pennsylvania
when he gets his age Barren his under age or without Head
then given with his.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my three friends
Wilson, Seal and William Alexander my trustees, my executors
to this my last will & Testament and I do by this will, in
testament before the date of this above, I declare this to
my last will and testament, the things herein written in no
contradict my said original writing and you above written.

In the town of Yorktown this 28th day of June in the year
one thousand seven hundred and seventy six. I Joseph Alexander of Yorktown formerly in
North Carolina living except sick & weak in body tho' of perfect
understanding and memory calling unto mind the mortality of
mortal body and knowing that it is appointed for all men and
to die do make and constitute this my last will & Testament
and I do in this first place most humbly beseeche my God
to send my soul unto that every body to be buried decently at the
discretion of my executors in confidence of the resurrection
at the last day. Additionally I do constitute it my will that upon
my decease the same Alexander may be buried in the old State Chapel
of my estate to dispose of it & paying to my executors
and to the attorney all my expenses which is the sum of five
and I do bequeath the same to the poor people of my estate.

to be divided among the children to my son Daniel Alexander and Deborah Alexander & to my daughter Elizabeth Alexander & Agnes Alexander, and I do say & declare unto the trustees arising from the sale of my negroes which I allow to be set to be equally divided among the above mentioned Children. Also do I give unto to furnish my son in plantation which I have but one mother is to have the same in order to maintain the Children while she remains & married & on her marriage to be given up to her aforesaid Eldest Son, and upon her marriage it shall be set aside for her use & maintenance 20 years of age, and so shall shall be for his youngest brother George 20 years of age and for his sister Deborah 20 years & 20 years from the time of age. And I order & command to be paid to learning of the said son letters of £100 per year in addition to what he has got by his said wife.
