- 5. I give also to my well beloved son Matthew my clothes &
 my saddle & bridle & the third of the money that is now lying
 in Andrews hand and the remainder to be divided among
 three of my Daughters that is Jean & Sother & Elizabeth
- Then I give & bequeath to my Grand Children viz James & Matthew
 Peter and Robert and Andrew the p. of one whole man
 that my Grandson Andrew Seepie bring let the price to be
 equally divided among of them above mentioned the man

that is appointed, for all men and to die. Do make & confirm
this my last Will & Testament that in to say Prince, full

to be sold and all the money arising from such sale
to be divided Equally amongst two of my Grandsons

 with Legacies & bequested by me in any wise before this
 time made with and bequested Ratifying & confirming

 been made by me in person & I do hereby give & bequeath
 the same to you first above written -
