Christian to be & to be held for the rest of her life.

Item I order that at the decease or death of my beloved wife
the land to be sold & equally divided between my Daughters &
Son, Pether, Margaret, & Martha & Elizabeth & James.

Item. I do devise & bequeath to my beloved wife hereto before
& her choice of the man, & I do also give & bequeath of her third
part of all the movable property. Item. I do devise & bequeath
to my daughter Mary ten pounds & five pence of silver. Item I
do devise & bequeath to my Daughter Sarah ten pounds & ten
pence of silver. Item. I do devise & bequeath to my son James
Twenty pounds of silver. Item. I do devise & bequeath to my
beloved wife one Cow & half. Item. I order that my Movable
property to be sold or division of what is bequeathed & the
two parts I order to be equally divided my Daughters & Son
Pether & Margaret & Martha & Elizabeth & James.

I do hereby constitute my beloved wife Sarah & Sam Fishers
to be executors of this my last will & Testament, hereby I do
Revocate make void & disannul all former Wills & Testament
formerly made by me. Ratifying this only & last will when
of I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 24th day of
January in the year of our Lord 1784
