As to my worldly Estate I Will and positively Order that all my debts be paid - I Will to my sister Peggy my plantation that I now live upon I Will also to my sister Peggy my Desk & a large table - I Will also that my sister Peggy pay to my Brother Andrew also that she pay to my sister Nancy also that she pay to my Brother John, also that she pay to my sister Betty, also that she pay to my sister Sally each one of them thirty dollars in the space of two years after my death - I also will all my wearing clothes to my Brother Andrew Allison - I also will & bequeath my bed & furniture to my sister Betty Berryhill, also will my chest to Peggy Berryhill - I also will a small table to my Clerk I also will my Corn & fodder more saddle and bridle bows & bags be sold to pay my debts -

I constitute Andrew Clarke and Samuel Berryhill my Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 10th day of October 1811.
