as largely and ample to all intents & purposes as I myself might or could
do if I was personally present and attorney one or more under him for the
purposes herein to constitute & appoint and again at pleasure to revoke hereby Rat-
ifying allowing and confirming all and whatsoever my said said attorney
shall lawfully do in and about the premises by virtue hereof In witness whereof I
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Saint Andrews in the
Province of New Brunswick this Twenty Fourth day of May in the year of our
Lord one thousand Seven hundred & forty one
