In the name of God Amens
I declare & testaments of the County of Moore
& State of North Carolina being weak in body
but sound in mind & memory calling to the mind
the Mortality of the Body & knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die I do make this
my last will & testament & first I give &
commend my soul to God who gave it & my body
to the earth to be decently interred now with
respect to the worldly Estate with which God has
Blessed me I devise & dispose of in the following
manner & form (viz)

Item 1st the rest of my personal property all
my lawful & just debt to be paid

Item 2d I devise & bequeath to my sister Catharine
McDonald one hundred and fifty eight acres of land
the head of the Big Soddy creek with the crop
now on hand

Item 3d I devise & bequeath to my sister Catharine
McDonald one horse man also one small trunk

Item 4th I devise & bequeath to my beloved mother

one large trunk

Item 5th I devise & bequeath to my sister Catharine
McDonald one Saddle now in the possession of Dr. Jno.
Fitter of Fayetteville

This concludes this my last will & testament
signed with my hand and seal & I do hereby appoint
my beloved friend Robert McLean my Executor
