In the Name of God Amens. I Donald Mc Donald of the County of Moore and State of North Carolina being now of delicate health of body but of sound Mind and Memory calling to remembrance the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make publish and Ordain this as my last Will and Testament as touch all the worldly substance with which it has pleased God to bless me in this life I will and dispose of the same in the following Manner, to witt,

In the first place I will and desire that my beloved wife Nancy Mc Donald shall have and enjoy the use of her person and ownership of all my real and personal property, after my death during her natural life to be disposed of by her at pleasure during her natural life. Item second at the death of my wife I will bequeath and desire that all my real Estate be then Equally divided There and There alike among my four sons Lucas Mc Donald, Horace Mc Donald, John Mc Donald and Donald Mc Donald to them and their heirs forever. Item the third I will to my son Lucas Mc Donald after his Mothers death my Negro Man Charles, to him and his heirs forever. Item the fourth I will to my son George Mc Donald after his Mothers death old Harry and his wife Rachel and Little Harry to him and his heirs forever. Item the fifth I will and desire to my son John Mc Donald after his Mothers death my Negro boy Rob and any gold or silver to him and his heirs forever. Item the sixth I will to my son Donald Mc Donald after his Mothers death my Negro woman Lucy with her full increase and any boy named Sam, to him and his heirs forever. Item the seventh I will and bequeath to my Daughter Christiana now Christiana Mc Call Washington and Lucy and likewise the first child also shall have to her and her heirs forever after her mothers death. Item the eighth I will and bequeath to my daughter Anna my Negro girl Ruth and boy Williams after her mothers death to her and her heirs forever. Item the ninth I will and bequeath to my Daughter Catharine after her mothers death Lucy and a stolen to her and to her heirs forever. Item the tenth I will and desire that all the increase or children which may have between now and the death of my wife

Except her first child which I have already willed to Catharine Baker shall at the death of my wife be Equally divided among my sons then surviving or their lawful issue. Item the eleventh I will and bequeath that after my life my death the whole of my Stock then on hand together with all household and kitchen furniture and other furniture shall then be Equally divided among all my children then surviving or their lawful issue. Item the twelfth I will and desire that if either of my Sons or Daughters here before named should die without lawful issue before their Mothers death that then and in that case their Shares shall be Equally divided among the survivors or survivors of my Children or their lawful issue. Item the thirteenth I will and desire that my Executors here after named shall collect all my debts that may then be due and pay all the debts that my then Master owing, and should my incoming debts then owing to me be insufficient to pay all my debts I will and desire that my Executors shall sell so much of my Stock as can be spared and all the surplusous produce that may be spared after such parting my Wifes and what part of my children may remain with her until my debts are all paid. Itemmately and appoint my beloved son Horace Mc Donald and my son in Law Mr. A. Mc Call Executors to this my last will and testament, and do hereby revoke and disannul all and every other former will and testament by me made or executed testifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal this the 27th day of November AD 1822
