Samuel Jarvis Will

In the name of god amen May 13. I Samuel
Jarvis of Hampton County 17th of plantation being
weak of body but of perfect memory of mind
thanks be given unto god therefore but knowing the
futility of the flesh & that it is appointed for all
men Once to die I make this my last will
and testament in manner and form following

Then I give unto my son John Jarvis one hundred
or eighty acres of land more or less lying on
Johns Bluffs & Bayman's River Land to him
and his heirs forever one horse one cow & saddle

Then I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel
Jarvis three hundred acres of land lying on
the Occomocky swamp with one negro girl Peggy
he then above Samuel Jarvis paying the sum
of twenty pounds which money to be
equally divided among all my children

Then I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin
Jarvis the remainder of plantation to him and
I leave him containing two hundred acres
More a gift to him and his heirs forever
with a negro girl named to him & his heirs forever

Then I give unto my Daughter Mary twenty Whittings
Then I give unto my Daughter Mary Bunk five pounds
Then I give unto my Son John Jarvis five pounds
Then I give unto my Daughter Ella Jarvis five pounds
Then I give unto my Daughter Hannah Jarvis five
pounds

Then I give and bequeath unto my dear well beloved
wife Mary Jarvis during her widowhood or
life time all my stock of cattle horses sheep
hens and all my house hold furniture with all
my working tools of all sorts then after her
decease to be equally divided among all my children
I do likewise constitute and appoint my son
Samuel & Thomas Parker whole and sole Executors
of this my last will and testament with full
my hand and seal Samuel Jarvis Esq
