John I give unto my Nephew Samuel Henshaw by my Last Will &
his heirs forever. —

After I give unto my beloved Friend Young Johnson all the residue
of my Property let it consist of what it may to him like his friend

I give unto my friend Young John, the book that my man
 is with fold with by Captains Hagen; Hence to him this
 I shew I appoint Samuel Morrison & Young John my
 Executors of this my last will & Testament & do hereby dis-
 - annul all wills by any other man made by me Confirming this
 I do other to be my last will & Testament, In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th of July 1811-

Benjamin Jordan's Will

The name of Goas Linca. I Begonia of Northampton County Prince
of North Carolina being of sound & perfect memory Superseding for father
same at the 25th day of December in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred & one make & confirm this to be my last Will
and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say). —

In pursuance I give unto my son Arthur Swales a tract of land in the County of Northampton Beginning at a branch that runs out of the Reay Branch thence up the said Branch to the Road thence up the Road to a bar of marked Trees thence along said bar to the Country line thence along the Country line to John Evans bar to to Joseph Smith's line thence by his line to Littleberry Smith's line thence to the Reay Branch thence down the Reay Branch to the first Station also two Negroes saved Namely Chumaid which Negroes are now in the possession of him & his heirs forever

Nov 1 I gave into my daughter Elizabeth Harrison one hundred marks named
ably and all of her children to her John Harrison.

June 2 I gave unto my son in law Thomas Dyer one Negro, named
 Ned to him & his heirs forever —

Mar 3 I gave into my daughter Charlotte Baylins one hundred and
Molly & girl Patience to her & her sister Lawrence —

Nov 4 I gave unto my Son Benjamin Jordan an horse & fellow
Mingo girl & told also the said Effusion to him & his fellow

Item 5 I give unto my two Son, Thiel Jordan & George Fordlae
all my land at Sandspore given ~~me~~ ^{by} to be equally divided
when my Son George dies, to the age of Eighteen years to
them & their Heirs forever

John 6 I give to my son George Jordan the following Slaves one
Major Lloyd Adams and one Negro girl Lenny and Maria four
Lous & Coker are His Affectionate by Choice of all the Slaves of his
to receive the same when he arrives to the age of Eighteen
Years to him & his heirs forever also one share of the
value of twenty five pounds Virginia Money to receive out of
my Estate not herebefore given away to him His heirs forever
