

Holliday Haley's Will. In the name of God Amen I Holliday
Haley of Sampson County N.C. Carolina of present in good health sound mind
and memory thanks be to God therefor, but calling to mind the mortality of
my body, doth give and despose of my goods and chattels in manner and
form as following:-

I Item. I bind unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Haley one third part of all
my lands; my will and desire is that the rest of the plantation wherein
I now live to be laid off in such a manner as for her to have the pri-
-lege of half the dwelling house and kitchen during her natural life
also I bind unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Haley seven negroes known
by the names of Harry, Boston, Nellie, Mark, old Simey, Kizziah and
Tempy during her natural life. I also bind unto my beloved wife
Elizabeth Haley my large sorrel mare and colt and four cows of calves
five swine and pigs, forty bushels of corn one Bed and furniture, one
chest, one lot about table two pks one pair three earthen dishes one dozen
earthen plates one set knives and forks and one peacock bacon during
her natural life.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Haley one third part of
all the lands that I now own and half of all my stock of horns cattle
sheep and hogs house hold and kitchen furniture corn fodder and
every other article that I have not left unto my beloved wife Elizabeth
Haley to him and his heirs forever. Also I give and bequeath unto
my son Henry Haley nine negroes known by the names of Isaac,
Sam, Dick, old Joseph, old Sarah, little Simey, Anna and Patti to
him and his heirs forever.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my son Hudson Haley one third part of all my
lands and my will and desire is that the provision to be made for him to enjoy the
priviledge of half of the dwelling house and kitchen on the plantation
whereon I now live, to him and his heirs forever. Also I give unto my son
Hudson Haley nine negroes known by the names of Peter Simon, Ephraim
James, Neville, old Sarah Hannah, Jordan and Roger to him and his heirs
forever, also half of my stock of fatted Horses Sheep Dogs Household & Kitchen
furniture corn and fodder and plantation utensils that I have not
already given away to my wife Elizabeth Haley, to him & his heirs forever.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my grandson Holliday Haley son of Mathew
Haley son of William Haley one negro boy by the name of Lewis to him &
his heirs forever, provided the said Holliday Haley doth before he comes
to lawful age my will and desire is that the said negro should go to his
brother James Haley.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my grandson Benjamin Harrison Pritchard
son of Joshua Pritchard one negro boy by the name of Squire to him

and his heirs forever, provided the said Benjamin Harrison Pritchard
doth before he comes to lawful age my will and desire is that the
negro boy shall go to his brothers and sisters if he has any, if not the
said negro to descend back for the benefit of my two sons Henry Haley and
Hudson Haley, to them and their heirs forever.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my son Isaac Haley five shillings.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my son Holliday Haley five shillings.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy Clark five shillings.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy Fox five shillings.

I Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Polly Pritchard five shillings.

My will and desire is that the land and negroes and incidents of the
said negroes that I have left unto my wife and every other
article that I have left unto her to be equally divided between my
two sons Henry Haley and Hudson Haley at the death of my wife
to them and their heirs forever, the part of the houses that I have
left unto my wife my will and desire is shall belong unto my
son Hudson Haley at her death, my will and desire is that of either of
my sons Hudson Haley or Henry Haley should die without a lawful
issue that the property that I have given him should go to the
surviving son, my will and desire is that all my just debts
should be paid out of the property that I have given to my sons
Hudson Haley and Henry Haley to be mutually sustained by both.
And I do appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth, James Haley, Henry
Haley and Hudson Haley, whole and sole executors of this my
last will and Testament, this amending and making void all other
will by me hitherto made, in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 2nd day of February 1808.

John Pritchard who entered into bond in the penalty of £30,000 with
Mark the said Holliday to certify and record.
