Health and knowing not the day of my death yet
being of perfect mind and Memory desire it
necessary to constitute this my last Will and
Testament, and first of all I do assign my

spirit to god that gave it, hoping that it ¹⁰³
may and through faith do believe that it will
be raised at the general Resurrection and admitted
with this Body and received into glory and
next of all I do resign my Body to the earth
with all the charges of a decent Burial AND
furthermore in regard of my worldly Goods, Chattels
Pands and Instruments by these presents do will
and confirm as follows. A certain tract and
parcel of land lying and being in the County and
State aforesaid on the Yadkin River below the mouth
of flat swamp on the north side of said river, contain-
ing three hundred acres more or less agreeable to
the surveying thereof. To my wife Hannah Davis during
her widowhood, remains and remanded to my daughter
Elizabeth Davis with all the rights better and ap-
pertaining therunto belonging, to have and to
hold forever I slight of down excepted. The above
land to be dealt with agreeable to the last will
and Testament of John Davis deceased between
Bryja Davis & David Davis, Furthermore
my part of the homestead plantation agreeable
to the last will of John Davis my Father

104) I constitute to my Natural born son Rubin
Davis, born of Sarah M. Hartney to have and to
hold during life likewise One Mare two years old
black. I bequeath to my Wife likewise one Brindle
Cow with Calf and one Red Heifer to my Wife
together with one Leather Bed and furniture
and Bedstead brought to me by my Wife to
return to her again at her marriage. I WILL
One Chest, One Trunk 3 Chairs and one looking
glass, two Pewter plates, six earthen plates, two ear-
then flatters to be the property of my Wife, the rest
of my Goods to be sold agreeable to Law and dispo-
sed of to pay my lawfull Debts, if any remaining
to be disposed of to my Wife. IN WITNESS WHEREOF
whereof and for which I do appoint William Moore
Executor and Hannah Davis my wife Executrix
in all cases touching the premises, and in test-
imony whereof I do hereunto set my hand and
affix my seal this first day of January 1784

Elizabeth my dearly beloved wife is to have one third of my
moveable goods and the said place where she now lives
is to be divided in four parts where I make over the
said place unto my well beloved sons Henry Matthias
Frederick and Joseph
