 Item. I Give & Bequeath to my Son James one Plantation Situate

Item. At the Decease of my wife Mabel it is my will &

Mannor (Beginning) at a 'Ozan' Above my mannor Fence
and so on each Side up Hogans Creek as far as a Survey will
