my Last Will and Testament (Viz) And first of all I give  
my Soul to him that Gave it me, and my body to be Buried by  
my Executor hereafter named and as to the worldly Goods  
wherewith it hath Pleased God to bless me Now In the manner  
and form following Item I Give and Bequeath to my  
Dear Wife Mirri The Plantation wherein I now live Together  
with all my Household Goods & Stock of all kinds During her  
Life. I Give & Bequeath to my Son Hesekiah One Improvement  
Situate in the County of Surry Joining the Improvement of  
Thomas Duran in on the East Side of the Narral.  
Item I Give & Bequeath to my Son James one Plantation situate

in the County of Surry Joining the Improvement of David  
Allen on the west Side of the Canal.

Item. At the Death of my wife Mabel it is my will & pleasure  
that my Son John be possessed with my Mannor  
Plantation. Item. It is my will & pleasure that my Son  
William have A Pance of Woodland Ground above my  
Mannor Beginning at a Organ Above my mannor fence  
and so on each Side up Hogans Creek as far as a Survey will  
extend In Wilmcs I have set my hand & seal this 8<sup>th</sup>  
of April in the year of our Lord 1777
