afforesaid being of Sound mind and of disposing habits, do
make and declare this my last will and Testament, I resign
my Soul to God who gave it. I resign my body to the dust
from which it came. I desire, first, that my funeral expences
& all my just debts be paid. I will and desire that all of
my property be equally divided between all of my children,
including my Wife Nancy to have an equal Share ^{ea} with ~~such~~ child.
All my children will render in the amt. that each one has re-
ceived previous to this time. I will unto John Smith one
Hundred Dollars for his Support to be placed in the Hands of
James Thompson. I do hereby nominate W^m. Tucker and Reuben
Tucker my Executors. I have here Set my hand and affixed my
Seal, this tenth day of March 1841.
