JOHN SMITH

In the name of God amen

I John Smith of the County of Pendleton, and State of S^c Carolina, being weak in Body, but of sound Memory, (blesed be God--) do this 5th of Decem^r 1792 -- and of the soverinity and Independincey of America the seventeenth, make and publish this my last will and Testament, in Manner following (that is to say) first I give to my Mother Rachel Smith, the Plantation and tract of Land whereon she now livs Containing one Hundred Acres more or lefs -- to enjoy and pofsefs the same During her Natural life, and after her death, I devise the same to William Smith, Sun of my Sister Mary Smith and his heirs forever, Also I give and bequeath to my Mother affors^d - one bay Mare and other property. Notes and Book accounts -- Also I give to s^c William Smith Sun of Mary^s one young bay Mare or filley -- And I make and Ordain hir my Mother Affors^d Sole Executrix of this my will, in trust for the intent and purpofses, in this my Will Contained -
