Barnwell District } Thames Odom of the State and dis-
trict aforesaid A widow bed sick and weak in body but of
sound mind and memory praised be God for the care I do make
and declare this my last will and Testament in manner and
form following first I give and bequeath unto James Colline
my Son in law one mare and Colt known by the name of pockett,
also one Negro man named Tanb, also all my Stock of Horses, ex-
cept one yearling mare Colt, and all my stock of Hogs marked
with a Crop and under keel in Each Year also all my planta-
tion tools, Secondly I give to my ~~Daughter Mary~~ wife
of James Colline, all my household and kitchen furniture, my
saddle and bridle and half of my wearing apparel also all my
poultry of every description the same to be enjoyed by both of
them their heirs Executors administrators and assigns for ever
Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my daughter ~~Lydia Odom~~ also all
my Stock of Cattle marked with a Crop and underkeel in each
ear also one yearling mare Colts with all their futir Increase
also half of my wearing appearrel and at her death to be ~~as~~
equally divided between the Children of ~~Lydia~~ Mary Collins; it is
also my will and pleasure that the above Named James Colline
shall have all my Corn feeder pease and potatoes wheat and
rice which is now a growing. It is also my desire th t all
the Rest of my Children namely Catherine Colline Sarah Obannon
should have two dollars to each of them of out of my Estate al-
so my Grand Children namely Mary Wedaniel Sarah Devitt mary
Colline should have the like sum out of my Estate all the

form following first I give and bequeath unto James Collins my son in law one mare and Colt known by the name of pockett, also one Negro man named Tom, also all my Stock of Horses, except one yearling mare Colt, and all my stock of Hogs marked with a Crop and under keel in Each Year also all my plantation tools, Secondly I give to my daughter Mary ~~and~~ wife of James Collins, all my household and kitchen furniture, my saddle and bridle and half of my wearing apparel also all my poultry of every description the same to be enjoyed by both of them their heirs Executors administrators and assigns for ever Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lydia Odem all my Stock of Cattle marked with a Crop and underkeel in each ear also one yearling mare Colt with all their futir Increase also half of my wearing apparel and at her death to be equally divided between the Children of Mary Collins; it is also my will and pleasure that the above Named James Collins shall have all my Corn fodder pease and potatoes wheat and rice which is now a growing. It is also my desire that all the Rest of my Children namely Catherine Collins Sarah Obannon should have two dollars to each of them of out of my Estate also my Grand Children namely Mary McDaniel Sarah Revitt Mary Collins should have the like sum out of my Estate all the rest Residue of my personal Estate of whatsoever kind then may be I do will to pay my just debts and funeral Charges I do Constitute and appoint James Collins Executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this twenty first day of May one thousand and eight hundred & eight, Signed Sealed and in presence
