 I Florence Righton of the City of Charleston in the
 State aforesaid widow being of sound Mind and memory and un-
 derstanding praised be almighty God for the same do make and
 publish this my Last Will & testament in the manner and form
 following that is to say, First I desire to be decently and
 plainly buried in the Church yard of the Scotch or first
 Presbyterian church yard and my worldly Estate I give and de-
 vise as follows, namely, I direct all my lawful debts as may
 be due at the time of my death or may come due hereafter to
 be paid by my Executor hereafter named according to the order
 and Succession prescribed by the act of the Legislature, also
 it is my will if I should not leave assest in hands Sufficient
 to pay and discharge such debts as may at the time of my death
 or some or all of them and the Legacies hereafter mentioned
 then and in that case I hereby give my Executor full power
 and authority & require him to exercise the same to sell alien
 & bargain & convey all my real or personal estate which I may
 die pofsefsed of or ought to be pofsed of or So much thereof
 either of the real or personal as may be Sufficient to pay and
 discharge the said debts and Legacie hereby giving him full
 power to exercise his discretion which of the two namely the
 real or personal property he shall dispose of for the dis-
 charging & paying the said debts aforesaid. Item I give and
 bequesth unto Thomas Choate, mariner, in trust for Susan Mary
 Jane Choate wife of the said Thomas Choate and his heirs for
 ever, all my real and personal Estate to be in no wise Sub-
 ject to or Liable for the debts or incumberances or contracts
 of him the said Thomas Choate or any futer husband which the
 said Susan Mary Jane may have and I do hereby give full power
 and authority to the said Thomas Choate to sell alien & dis-
 pose of any and all such property as he may hold by Virtue here-
 of in trust for his said wife provided however his said Wife
 Sanctions & approve the Selling and disposing.....

which Sanction and approval to be evinced by his joining in the deed or conveyance which may ^{be} deemed necessary for the selling and disposing of the same. Lastly I hereby appoint Thomas Choate beforementioned sole executor of this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hands and Seal this thirteenth day of March in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and twenty Six and in the fifteenth Year of the Sovereignty and Independance of the United States of America, the word mind in the 1st & Susan in the 26 line are interlined being left out.
