I have Bargained Sold & delivered & by these Presents in due form of Law Do Bargain, Sell & deliver unto y<sup>t</sup> said W<sup>m</sup> Rhett twelve negro men named Dennis, Harry, Simba, Jack, Jupiter, Bruffo, Dick, Shadrach, Peagues, Simon, Colly & Longsby, two of which said negroes Dick & Thomas being Servants, To W<sup>m</sup> Rhett & W<sup>m</sup> Hobbs aforesaid Bargained Promised unto y<sup>t</sup> said W<sup>m</sup> Rhett his Executed Administrators & Assigns to y<sup>t</sup> on his Death bed or before of y<sup>t</sup> said W<sup>m</sup> Rhett his Executed Administrators & Assigns for ever, At the first and so Nathaniel Johnson for my self my Executed Administrators & Assigns Bargained Promises unto y<sup>t</sup> said W<sup>m</sup> Rhett his Executed Administrators & Assigns against all Persons shall remain in my favor ever defensed by y<sup>t</sup> said W<sup>m</sup> Rhett & his Executed Administrators & Assigns to y<sup>t</sup> said W<sup>m</sup> Rhett his Executed Administrators & Assigns.
