

WILL OF

HUMPHREY BARNET

In the name of God Amen, the twenty fourth day of December in the year 1790. Humphrey Barnet of the State of the State of South Carolina Camden District being very sick and weak in Body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God therefore. Calling unto mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament (that is to Say) principally & first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the Hand of Almighty God that give it and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be Buried in decent Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executors, nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I Shall receive the Same again by the mighty Power of God and touching my Worldly Estate Wherewith it hath please God to bless me in this Life. I give Devise & Dispose of the Same in the following manner & form I do give and bequeath unto my oldest Son Robert I cut him out with one Shilling Sterling. I likewise give to my Son Michael one Hundred and fifty acres of Land off the lower End of the track by paying out of it one likely Negro Boy or girl not under fourteen years of age nor over five and twenty. And to my youngest Son John I give my Wagon. Likewise my anvil & hammers and a Bay mare and Coult one cow called Spot and her calf & one cow called Dafy & the biggest bull and one half of the best Barrows and as for the rest of the hogs twelve months from this Date John is to have two thirds of them, And one rifle gun & Smooth Bore. And my oldest Daughter Sarah one Negro Boy or girl afore Said that Michael is to pay one Cow Called pretty & her calf & yearling & pidy cow and her calf & one heffer called browny & Spot heffer & a Small black heffer & one yearling Bull & two of the big Barrows, the Redhead Horse & mare. The Bay Stallion Colt & the old black Horse & the one half of the one third of the hogs abovementioned when the are divided, The upper Hundred Acres of land is to be Sold & fifty at the hanging

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rock. And one third of the price I allow for my Second Daughter Mary, one third of the price of the above mentioned Land I give to my third Daughter Diana, & two of the big Barrows and the one half of the one third of the above S. hogs. one Black mare and colt

. And one third of the price of the above mentioned Land to my youngest Daughter Rebel. And I do Likewise Constitute make and Ordain Michael Barnett Executor and Diana Hester Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament, and I do hereby utterly Disallow revoke & disannul all & every other former Wills, Testaments and Legacies by me in any wise named ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my Last Will & Testament. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day and year above Written.
