Imprimis first after all Just Debts and funeral Charges paid, I
Give and Bequeath to all my Children an Equal Distribution of my
worldly Estate ----- Secondly all these Names Caty Gayden. Reuben
Collins. Elizabeth Jones. William Collins. Joseph Collins Nancy
Collins Beshaw Collins. Thos. Collins Sarah Collins -----
thirdly if any of the above mentioned Names Should Decease Not
Haveing issue of there own body there part to be Equally Divided
among the Rest of the above mentioned -----
Lastly I Do Here by Constitute and appoint my Eldest son Reuben
Collins and my son in law John Gayden to this my last Will
and testament Disannulling all Other testaments wills or Cordicils
of wills by Me Made in Witnefs whereof I Have Hereunto Set my
Hand and Seal this tenth day of July in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven Hundred and Ninety one in sixteenth year of the
Independence of the United States of America
