ISAAC GRIFFIN

In the name of God Amen. I Isaac Griffin of the District of Newberry and in the State of South Carolina being of sound mind and disposing mind memory. but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and being desirous of disposing of all such worldly estate as it hath, pleased God to bless me with. do make and ordain this my last will in manner following that is to say.

First. I desire that all my Just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my Executor, and if there should not be Money sufficient belonging to my Estate. at my decease, which may accumulate from the ensuing crop or other wise. I then desire that my Executor herein after named. may sell so much of my personal property. as may be sufficient to satisfie all Just and lawfull demands as may be produced against my Estate.

Secondly. I Give and bequeth to my Daughter Rachel Griffin her bed bedstead and its furniture and also one spinning wheel and cotton Cards. to her and her heirs forever.

Thirdly. I Give and bequeth to my Daughter Katherine Griffin. her bed bedstead and its furniter and alsoe one spinning wheel and cotton cards to her and her heirs for ever.

Fourthly. I Give and bequeth the remainder of all my personal and real Estate as is not heretofore disposed of. to my wife Rachel Griffin for and during her natural life only and at her decease. and not before, I Give and bequeth all my real estate. the tract containing one Hundred acres more or less of land I now reside on / Adjoining lands as follows south east John T. McNeel lands north east George Bebb lands north west Co. Samuel Cannons land and south east on Stephen Beards lands To my two youngest sons namely. George W. Griffin and

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lands To my two youngest sons namely, George W. Griffin and Henry L. Griffin Jointly and severly to them selves and their heirs for ever, and I alsoe Give to my son George W. Griffin one sorrel horse named bully four years old and alsoe one bed bedded and furniture to him and his heirs forever

I alsoe Give to my son Henry L. Griffin one sorrel Colt one year old and one bed bedded and furniture to him and his heirs for ever.

Fifthly, and lastly, at the death of my wife Rachel herein before mentioned, and after the property herein designated, and dis-

posed of as herein before ordained. then if any shall remain of my personal Estate so undisposed of I then require that my Executor. sell ^{all} ~~the~~ that may so remain or disposed of by this my said will, at publick sale. after giving legal notice of the same. and all the monies that shall arise therefrom shall be equally divided between the remainder and under named of my Children namely David Griffin, Silas Griffin Presha Brooks, ~~J. W. Griffin~~ Taly West Rachel Griffin, Katherine / to them only and their heirs heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever.-----

And lastly I do constitute and appoint my son Silas Griffin Executor of this my last will and testament. by me heretofore made.
