WILLIAM MOLLVEEN SEN^r.

The Last Will and Testament of William Mollveen Sen^r--

In The Name of God Amen, I William Mollveen Sen^r, of Prince
Fredricks Parish and State of South Carolina. Though weak of
Body, Yet of Sound Mind & Memory Blest be God, being Admon-
shed of my Mortality and of the Appointment for all men once
to die, do make this my last will & Testament as follows Viz--
First & principally, I give and Bequeath my Soul to God who
gave it me, & my body to the Earth, from whence it came, in
hopes of a glorious & happy Resurrection, at the last day,

Through the Merits of Christ my Redeemer Amen. Touching Such
Worldly Goods as God hath blest me with, I dispose of in,
the following Manner Viz. Item I give and Bequeath Unto my
beloved Wife Margaret Mollveen one Negroe wench Named old
Fibby, and a Riding chair & harness, and one Horse Bed &
furniture at her own Election also part of a tract of land
whereon I now live on the East Side of Indiantown--Swamp the
main Creek of the Sd, Swamp to be the dividing line & to Con-
tinue on Untill the main creek of Blk. Mingo Swamp, also a
tract of land Bought of Jn., McCottry to her during her life
& at her death the Sd, lands to Return to my Son William and
the Sd, personal property Shall be Equally divided between
Mary Ann Thos. & Margaret Mollveen by men chosen by Executors
herein after Named--Item, I give & Bequeath to my Son Wm. one
Negroe Man Named Bob and the said land at his Mothers death to
him and his Heirs and Assigns for Ever--Item, I give and Beque-
ath to my Daughter Jane one Negroe Boy Named Sam, to her & her
Heirs & assigns for Ever--Item, I give & Bequeath to my Son
James one Negroe Man Named Pinklea and the one Third of the

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furniture at her own Election also part of a tract of land

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James one Negroe Man Named Finklea and the one Third of the

Remainder of My lands that is unbequeath to him his, Heirs &

Afsigns for Ever--Item, I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Mary

one Negroe Woman Named Tenah to her & her Heirs & Afsigns for

Ever--Item, I give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Ann one

Negroe Woman Named Mindow to her & her Heirs & Afsings for Ever

Item, I give & bequeath to my Son Henry one Negroe Woman Named

Young Fibby and the one Third of the Remainder of my lands that

is unbequeath to him his Heirs and Afsigns for Ever--Item. I

give and Bequeath to my son Thomas one Negroe boy Named
Sambow and the one Third of the Remainder of my lands that is
unbequeath to him his Heirs and Afsigns for Ever--Item, I give
and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret one Negroe Girl Named
Phillas to her & her Heirs & Afsigns for Ever--Item I give to
my daughter in-Law Eliner Matthews & her Son John Five Shill-
ings a pice for there full parts or parts. of my Estate Real
or personal--Also it is my Will & Desire that if the above
Named Wenches Bequeathed to my Children Should have any Incre-
ase B efore my Death Accept Mindow and her Increase is to Re-
maine to my Daughter Mary Ann, and the Rest of the Increase of
the Other Wenches if any, bequeathed is to be Returned to the
Remainder and Residu of my Personal Estate, to be Equally
divided between my wife & Children, by five Judicious men
chosen by my Executors herein after Named, also that the sd,
Men to divide the sd, lands into three Shares that is Bequeath
to my Sons James, Henry & Thomas Equally between them, it is
also my desire that my Said Childrin Shall Receive there full
parts as they Marry or Arive at the age of Twenty one, And I do
hereby appoint W^m & Ja^s, McIlveen, W^m Ja^s, Cooper & Robert Gregg
my Executors of this my last Will & Testament and lastly I do
Acknoledge this my last Will and Testament, Revoking all other
Wills by me made heretofore, in witnefs hereof I have hereunto
Set my hand and Seal this day
