

In the name of God Amen--I James Crawford Senr. of the State and District aforesaid being of a good Old age but of perfect mind and Memory calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this as my last Will and Testament and first I Recommend my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken to buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors Nothing doubting but I shall receive the same again at the general Resurrection and my Soul into the hands of God who gave it. and as touching such worldly Estate as it has pleased God to bless me with, I give dispose of and bequeath in the manner following (Viz) first I allow all my Just debts to be paid & the balance to be disposed of thus, I will and Bequeath to my Beloved Wife Elizabeth, the plantation on which I now live together with my Stock of horses, Cattle hogs etc. with the household and Kitchen Furniture during her Natural life, and at her death (what is left) to be divided among my Children thus: I allow my Son Robert M Crawford to have one bed and Bedstead and the under bed and Clothing consisting of one Sheet Blankets, pillows and Counterpane Also one half of my stone Quarry Tract of land lying on part of King Mountain Near the Memorable hill Call'd the Battleground and the Crowbar between him and his Brother William for the use of the Quarry Also I allow my daughter Lucinda I. Hill at her mothers death the Spinning Wheel, Chards, Check Reel, Shelf and all the furniture thereof one Table one large Oven and lid one Skillet and small pot one Iron Shovel and poker with all her mothers Clothing--Also to my son William N. Crawford at his mothers death the plantation whereon I now live Together with all and singular the whole of the Stock and farming Utensils likewise the half of the Quarry Tract as named

before and all the other land I Own
and I do hereby Estaglish and Confirm this to be my last Will
and Testament and appoint my Sons Robert M. Crawford and William
N. Crawford to be the Executors of the Same
