I Richard Barnette being of sound & disposing mind & memory & calling to mind the uncertainty of life do make & ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & form following Viz.

1st. I desire that the whole of my Estate shall be in the possession & at the disposal of my wife Frances Parham Bonnette during her natural life or widowhood after the discharge of all my Just & lawfull debts which debts shall be paid by the sale of such property as my Executor shall think it most convenient to spare

2nd. as soon as either of the above named accurrences shall transpire I mean the death or Marriage of my wife my will is that my land shall be Equally divided between my two sons Jno. Allen Bonnette & Joseph Josiah Bonnette by valuation so that they shall not have actually more of my property than an equal dividend with the rest of my children & my wife if living

3rd. It is my will & intention that my wife & each of my children shall have an equal & proportionable share of my whole Estate & that Each one shall take possession of his or her Legacy as soon as he or She Shall attain to the age of twenty one years or be married

All the rest of my property both real ~~an~~ personal of whatsoever kind it may be not above particularly disposed of as well as

that which may accrue as the result of rents, hire, or labour to my heirs and their assigns forever
I give & bequeath to be disposed of as the above named Estate

Lastly I do constitute & appoint my wife Frances P. Bonnette

my Executrix & Joel S. Bonnette my Executor of this my last
will & Testament by me heretofore made in testimony whereof
I have set my hand & affixed my seal this 29th day of October
1834
