#### Singleton, William

He served thirty-one days in the militia during 1782. A.A.7048; I30; U351.

#### Singleton, William, Jr.

He served in the cavalry under Colonel Peter Horry. C503.

#### Singley, Jacob

He served in the militia under Col. Waters. A.A.7049; X2412.

#### Sinkler, James

#### Sinkler, Peter

He served five months and nine days as a cornet in the cavalry under Col. Hezekiah Maham during 1782. A.A.7052; H261.

#### Sinn, Frederick

He served as a surgeon in an artillery regiment from 1 January 1780 and was taken prisoner at the fall of Charleston. He was exchanged during October 1780 and served to the close of the war. Heitman, p. 498.

#### Sinquefield, Francis

He became a captain in the Rangers during November 1775 and was on an expedition under Maj. Williamson. In addition, he served as a captain in the militia under Gen. Pickens and was dead prior to July 1785. Yearbook, 1893; A.A.7053; T657.

#### Sinquefield, Samuel

He served as a captain in the militia during

1782. S.C.H.&G., V, 59; A.A.7054; X1995.

#### Sinton, Charles

He served as a captain under Col. Samuel Williams during 1779. (Martin, John, S15935).

#### Sissan, Fred

While serving under Capt. Solomon Pope and Col. LeRoy Hammond, he was captured and executed by the Tories. Chapman, p. 68.

#### Sissans, Joshua

See Josiah Sisson.

#### Sisson, Fred

He served in Capt. Sterling Turner's Company of Volunteers on Horseback. (Corley, Abner, S21707).

#### Sisson, Frederick

He served as quartermaster in Capt. William Butler's Company of Volunteers on Horseback from 1 September 1781 to 1 March 1782 (Corley, Abner, S21707); N.A.246; A.A.7055; T633.

#### Sisson, Josiah

He served twenty days as a footman under Capt. Granby and Col. Brandon from 12 May to 12 February 1780. In addition, he served eighty days as a horseman and one hundred three days as a footman under Capt. William Grant and Col. Brandon from November 1780 to January 1782. A.A.7056; X1864; X1926.

#### Sisson, Martin

He served as a private and lieutenant in the militia from 15 September 1781 to 5 May 1782. A.A.7057; V330.

#### Sisson, William

He served as second lieutenant in Capt. Sterling Turner's Company of Volunteers on Horseback. (Corley, Abner, S21707); A.A.7058; X298.

#### Sistrunk, Gasper

He served as an adjutant in the militia under Gen. Henderson and Gen. Sumter. A.A.7059; T197.

#### Sitlers, Frederick

He served in the Third Regiment. N.A.244; N.A.853.

#### Sittles, Bushwood

He served in the state troops under Lt. Col. Samuel Hammond. M70.

#### Sizemore, Ephraim

He served in the militia after the fall of Charleston. A.A.7060; T653.

#### Sizemore, George

He served in the Lower Ninety Six Regiment of Militia after the fall of Charleston. A.A.7061; T654.

#### Sizemore, Noel

He served in the militia after the fall of Charleston. A.A.7062; T656.

#### Sizemore, William

He served in the militia after the fall of Charleston. A.A.7063; T655.

#### Slaggs, James C.

b. 1763, Laurens County, S. C.

d. 12 December 1838

He enlisted during 1780 under Captain John Roebuck and Col. Roebuck. Later, he joined Gen. Morgan and was in the battle at Cowpens. He was also in the battle at Guilford Court House. In addition, he was under Gen. Sumter and was at the fall of Orangeburg. He was under Col. Pickens and was at the siege of Ninety Six, the battle at Kettle Creek and one at Waxhaw. (Moved to Tenn.)

#### Skain, Adam

S11404

While residing in the Ninety Six District, he enlisted during July 1776 under Capt. Daniel McKay, Lt. Lowell Otterson and Col. Thomas. He marched against the Indians and was in one battle. Next, he was under Capt. William Farr. In 1779, he was under Capt. McKay and Col. Brandon. At one time, he was under Capt. Joseph Hughes. After the fall of Charleston, he joined Capt. Johnson and Gen. Sumter. He was also under Capt. Brown, who was killed at Backstock's Plantation. Thereafter, he was under Capt. Hollingsworth. He was in the battle at Cowpens under Colonel Brandon. (Moved to Ala.) A.A.6809; X1869A; X3106.

#### Skain, Nicholas

He enlisted, while residing in Union District, during 1780, under Col. Farr as one of his lieutenants. He was in a skirmish in Union District and one near Ninety Six. At sometime, he served under Capt. Joseph Hughes and Col. Brandon. A.A.6811; X2414.

#### Skeen, William

He served in the Third Regiment during 1779 under Captain Uriah Goodwin. S.C.H.&G., V, 150.

#### Skain, Adam

He served eighty-nine days in the militia as a lieutenant under Gen. Marion. A.A.7066; I551; X193.

#### Skelton, John

He served in an independent company from 21 April 1779 to 2 July 1780. A.A.4800; I18.

#### Skelton, Robert

He served one hundred fifty-six days as a horseman under Capt. Moses Wood and Col. Roebuck during 1780. He lost a horse in service during 1782. A.A.7065; X1927.

#### Skelton, Thomas

He served in the militia with Salathiel Heaton under Col. Brandon and others. A.A.3509; A.A.6813A; X3110.

#### Skelton, William

He served in the militia. Patriot Index Supplement.

#### Skene, James

He served in the Charleston Militia Regiment under Captain James Bentham during 1778. S.C.H.&G., LIII, 14.

He served in the militia and was at the fall of Charleston. Yearbook, 1897.

#### Skilling, William

He served in the First Regiment under Capt. Thomas Lynch during 1775. S.C.H.&G., I, 57.

#### Skinner, Thomas

He enlisted on 2 October 1775 in the Edisto Island Volunteer Militia under Capt. Joseph Jenkins. S.C.H.&G., II, 103.

#### Skinner, William

b. N. C.

He enlisted in the Rangers on 8 July 1775 under Capt. John Purvis and Col. Thomson. S.C.H.&G., I, 301; II, 185.

#### Skipper, Charles

He served in the Second Regiment under Capt. Peter Gray during 1779. Saffell, p. 291; N.A.246; N.A.853.

#### Skipper, Gilbert

He served in the cavalry under Col. Hezekiah Maham and Gen. Marion from 26 July 1780 to 20 January 1783. A.A.7068; A41; S.C.H.&G., V, 118.
