

David S Guinn Will

Washington County Tennessee August the 2nd 1880

Know all men by these presents that I David S Guinn of the County and State aforesaid considering that life is uncertain and death is sure and being of sound mind and memory doth make this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows viz

Item 1st After all my just debts and funeral expenses are paid I will and bequeath to my brother Matthew S Guinn and Elizabeth Jane his wife all the title claim and interest that I have in and to a certain tract or parcel of land on which I and my brother now live (formerly belonging to our father Thomas Guinn died) to have & to hold or dispose off as they may see fit.

Item 2nd Having an equal interest in the proceeds of the farm with my brother Matthew S Guinn and in all the live stock and all the farming implements of whatever kind in which I have an interest and all my personal property of whatever kind of which I am possessed I give and bequeath to my brother Matthew S Guinn and his wife Elizabeth Jane at my death.

I Constitute and appoint Joseph S Lyon of said County & State my Executor to settle up my estate according to the provisions of this my last will and testament.
