my death that my son Robert shall receive from my executors fifteen pounds Virginia money
& one horse to the same value, and to the said son Robert I do give or bequeath ten pounds
to be paid in the same manner as before said and to the said daughter Ellenor Mary
& my wife I give them ten pounds to each on condition that they do behave themselves in a
quiet manner to their mother and their sisters and to Ellenor these five pounds if the
estate is able and the amount that I have against said McCall whose estate is in the
hands of William Tupper in Pennsylvania to be divided equally among all my children of
Oblat and likewise the amount in the hands of said James Johnson living in Pennsylvania is
Oblat to be divided in the same manner and I do declare that all the Cattle and all
other property of this estate be for my wife as widow and I do appoint my
said wife and son to execute this my last will and testament according to
the contents all other will or wills made by me infirming this and no other to be
my last will and testament. In witness hereof I have set my hand and
sent signed and pronounced and delivered as my last will and testament and in
presence of us
