

## MACKENZIE late OF TARLOGIE.

EDWIN HALBERT MACKENZIE, Havelock House, co. Moray, and Avondale, co. Inverness, late of Tarlogie, co. Ross, late Seaforth Highlanders, ret. 1922, served in Great War in France 1917-19, afterwards in India, *b.* 24 March, 1899; *educ.* Brighton Coll. and R.M.C. Sandhurst.
